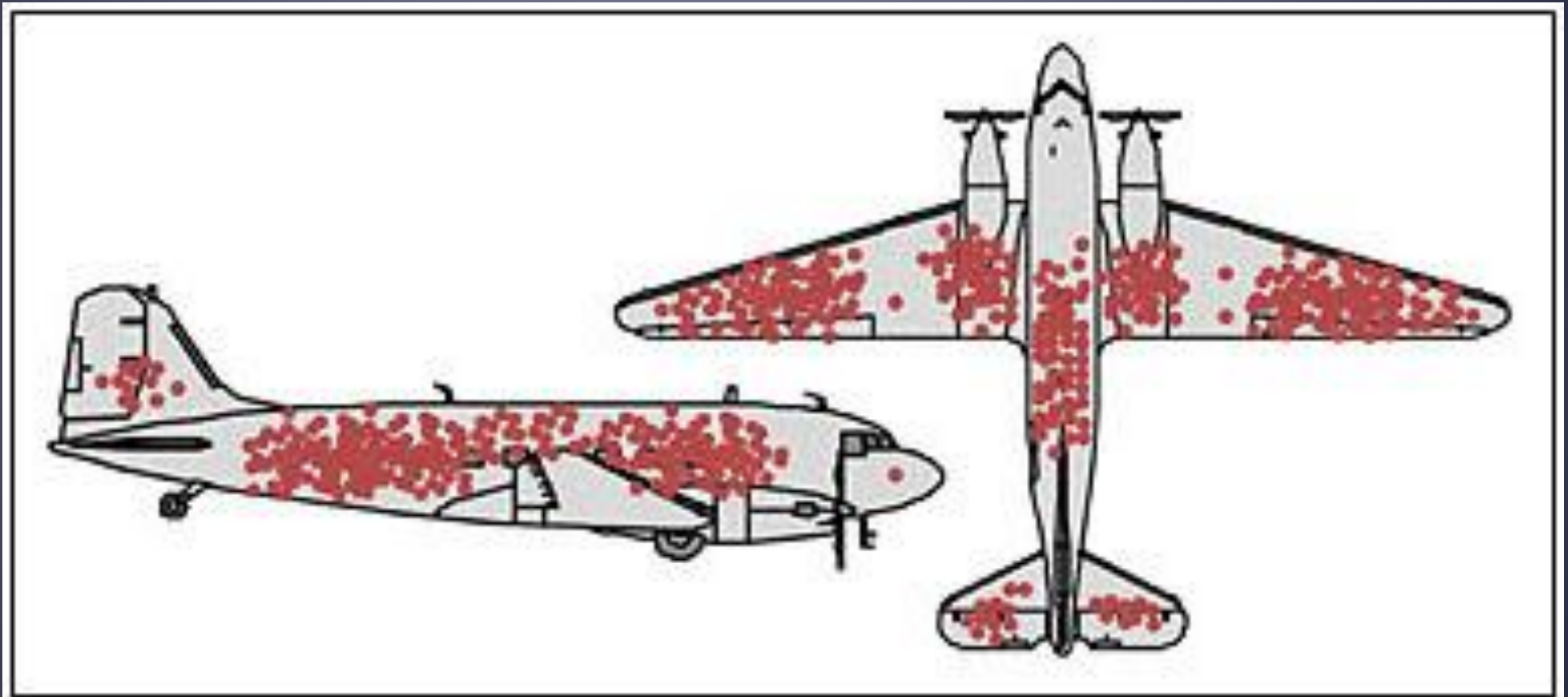

Alignment Check List

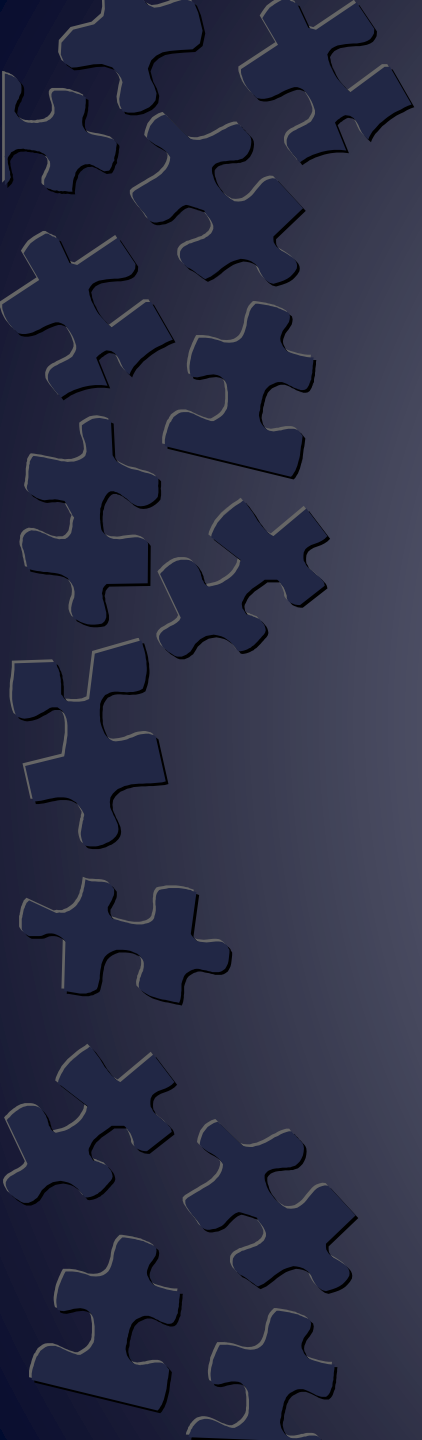
- › Rejoice with those that Rejoice
