- 5) These are the people who divide you, who follow mere natural instincts and do not have the Spirit.**

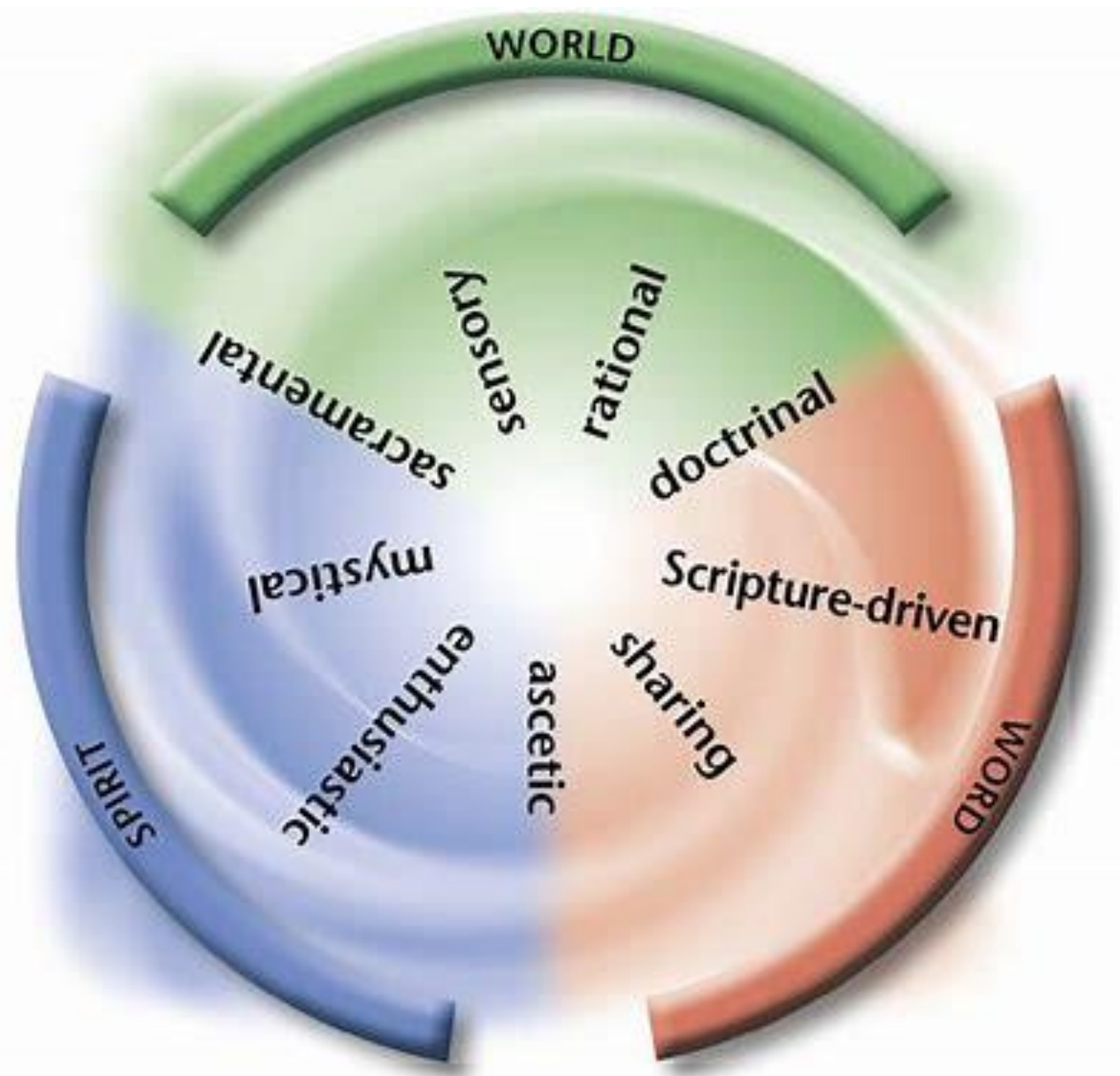
Jude-


Unity- Common bond and common purpose
